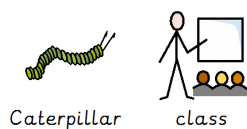

In Butterfly class, we have been learning about the fire fighters, as our theme this term is People Who Help Us. Fireman Sam gave us maths challenges with numbers and measuring time. We used a magic dice to do number counting and practice our number writing. We used the 1 minute timer to count how many jumps we can do before the timer finished. It was fun!.
