CAR PARK RULES

These guidelines have been produced to help ensure the safety of all visitors, parents, children, and staff at Marjory Kinnon School and we are grateful for your full cooperation. This document forms part of the Risk Assessment for the safety of everyone entering or leaving the school site.

Parents and carers are reminded that they are responsible for their children in the car park and they should be closely supervised at all times.

1	A 5-mile per hour speed limit applies throughout our site for all vehicles.
2	All drivers must exercise due care and attention when driving and manoeuvring in the car park.
3	Parents and carers are encouraged, where possible, to walk their children to school.
4	Pedestrians are to keep to the pathways and not walk across the car park area.
5	When alighting from vehicles, families are asked to make their way to the nearest pathway by the most direct or safest route to limit time walking across the Car Park.
6	Parents and carers must only park in the Parent Car Park and are asked to use this zone responsibly.
7	Disabled bays are only to be used by registered disabled badge holders.
8	Users of the Car Park do so at their own risk. Marjory Kinnon School will not accept responsibility for damage, accident or loss to vehicles or contents.
9	Parents and Carers are not to drive beyond the barrier, unless express permission has been given. This area is for staff parking, deliveries, or taxi / minibus drop-off and pick-up only.
10	All users of our Car Park are expected to be polite and courteous at all times, giving consideration to the fact that it is a school.
11	Children are permitted to ride bicycles and scooters to school and use the bike sheds for storage during the school day. Pupils must dismount from their bicycles and scooters when entering the school site and keep to the pathways. They are not to cross the car park or use the roads within the school site.
12	Use of our Car Park on the school site is a privilege and not a right. This may be withdrawn by the Governors if it is felt that the safety of the children is being compromised by inappropriate use of our Car Park.
13	Please take care in this busy Car Park. Parents must supervise their children at all times.
