KS1 Curriculum Map – Summer 1 – 2024-25

The children will be working towards the following skills tailored to the their needs:



Mathematics.

- Count up to 15 objects and recognise different representations of the number.
- Explore and order numbers to 15.
- Identify one more or fewer.

- Explore addition and subtraction.
- Compare two amounts.
- Explore doubling and halving numbers.

Measurement

- Explore and recognise the value of different coins.
- Explore and compare the capacities of everyday objects.
- Compare different volumes of objects.
- Explore and compare the weight of everyday objects.
- Explore the length of different objects and order them.

Art and Design

- Look at the way buses are painted.
- Look at different ways of transport.
- Paint different vehicles.
- Sing songs linked to the Naughty bus story.
- Explore different constructions using lego pieces.

Physical Development

Continued individualised time to focus on OT targets & tine motor skills: convey meaning.

Take part in co-ordination activities.

Understanding of the World

Science

- Make a circuit in order to put headlights into a bus or make street lights to place along a table top bus route.
- Explore how to make the bus go faster/ further (Pushing and pulling the bus).

- Explore bus maps of the local area.
- Make a map for the Naughty Bus.
- Explore different ways of transport and their environments.
- Explore roads and signs.
- Look at London tourist bus routes and identify where they stop.

Computing

- Explore Bee-bots.
- Programme Bee-bots by giving commands (pushing buttons) using visual instruction cards.
- Use the tablet to programme the blue-bot as above.
- Create Bee-bot mats.

- Behaviour needs.

Listening & Atention

- Give attention and respond to many familiar sounds, e.g. knocking the door.


Writing

- Explore mark-making tools independently.
- Explore making marks on different materials, e.g. sand, paper, water, etc.
- Use phonic knowledge to write words in different ways e.g. on sensory materials, using magnetic letters, overwriting yellow words, etc.
- Spell some words correctly.
- Trace/write some irregular common words.
- Trace/Copy/Write simple sentences.

- Share a poem book and turn pages independently.
- Enjoys looking at book pictures and points at them on request.
- Read and follow recipes and instructions.
- Read and understand simple and more complex sentences.
- Use phonic knowledge to decode regular and common irregular words and read them aloud.
- Demonstrate understanding when talking with others about what they have read.

Speaking

- Respond to interaction with others by smiling, looking, making sounds, using symbols, actions, signing or words.
- Find ways to express themselves effectively when talking about events that have happened or are to happen in the future.
