### Family comment:

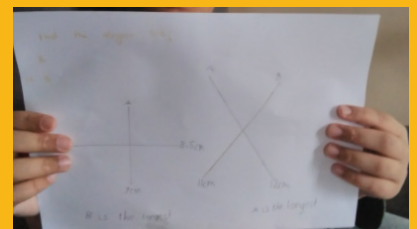
Sian enjoyed doing her maths. She thought this was ok.
