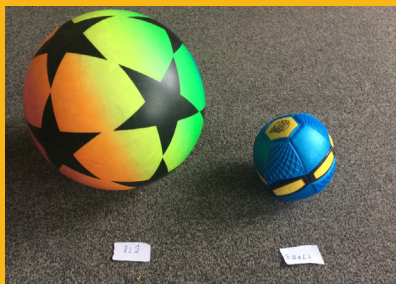

Big and Small - Estimating and Predicting

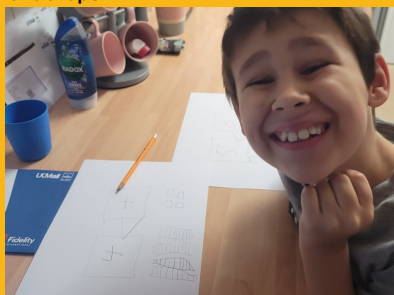


Family comment:
